### TEXAS LEGISLATURE

Through AMOT, the Texas Legislature has heard one clear voice on matters that are important to our businesses. AMOT's legislative accomplishments are unsurpassed. In addition to defending against the expansion of gambling activities that are detrimental to our industry, initiatives include:

#### **Defend Amusement Redemption Law**

AMOT has continually worked to defend Texas' Amusement Redemption Law against legal and legislative attacks. AMOT has worked to inform legislators about the importance of this law to our industry and the communities we serve while clarifying many of the laws misconceptions.

#### **Fight Gross Receipts Tax**

AMOT has worked with other business groups to fight off proposed business tax increases tied to school finance reform and property tax cuts. This challenge will continue during the upcoming special session and next year's regular session.

#### **Protect Against Occupations Code Changes**

AMOT worked tirelessly during the codification of the Occupations Code in 1999 to protect our industry.

### LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL COURT SYSTEMS

For almost 13 years, AMOT has retained legal counsel. This has allowed up-to-date and timely information to be provided to members through newsletters and live discussions. In addition, members have been able to communicate issues they have encountered around the state. This has provided the legal and lobby team a better understanding of the issues affecting our industry.

#### **Hardy v. State; Supreme Court of Texas (2001 – 2003)**

Participated in legal briefing and oral arguments before the Texas Supreme Court. Supreme Court opinion recognized and clarified amusement redemption law (47.01(4)(b) Texas Penal Code).

#### **AMOT v. TABC (1998 – 2005)**

Obtained a temporary injunction requiring the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission to follow Texas law regarding amusement redemption machines. The case was dismissed by an Agreed Order of Dismissal stipulating that the TABC no longer engages in the actions that formed the basis of AMOT's original suit as well as recognized the guidelines established by the Texas Supreme Court.

#### **Fought Attorney General Opinion Suspending State Law (1998 – 2003)**

When Attorney General Dan Morales issued an opinion that attempted to suspend Texas law in contravention of the Texas Constitution, AMOT launched a series of legal challenges that preserved the law. The success of these challenges was seen in the temporary injunction issued against the TABC.

### OTHER INITIATIVES

#### **Ensure Consistent Video Game Ratings**

Continue working to preserve consistency in video game ratings between Texas and Federal Law.

#### **Host AMOT State Convention**

AMOT hosts a state convention every year so that our members can meet manufactures, stay up to date with industry trends, and attend informative seminars.

#### **Monitor Texas Lottery**

AMOT's lobby and legal team continue to monitor the expansion of lottery activities in Texas that are detrimental to our industry.

#### **Serve as Resource for Cities & Counties**

AMOT has worked with various cities and counties in providing information and resource material on Texas' redemption law. AMOT has provided input on the adoption of various city ordinances relating to city regulation of redemption machines.

#### **Provide Scholarships**

For the past 38 years, AMOT has matched the AMOA scholarships. These scholarships

provide an opportunity for children of AMOT members to receive help with the expenses of entering college.

#### **Support the Make-A-Wish Foundation**

Since 2003, AMOT has adopted the Make-A-Wish Foundation as its primary charity. Through its members, AMOT has been able to donate \$10,560 to this worthwhile cause.
